Feel history, tradition and culture

Hakata Old Town, an area that flourished as the center of Hakata, the largest trading port city in medieval Japan, has a rich history, traditions, and culture dating back centuries. During the Hakata Old Town Festival (October 15-November 15, 2023), you can stroll through quiet streets lined with historic temples and shrines, amble around the area's lively shopping district, experience traditional Hakata crafts and arts, and feel the lifestyle and culture of locals, who are renowned festival lovers.

What is Hakata Old Town Festival?

For 32 days, you can have fun walking around town, dressing up in kimono, experiencing hands-on activities, and eating and drinking at a reasonable price! In November, a light-up walk will be held for visitors to enjoy temples and shrines at night. Please take this chance to come and experience the beauty of Hakata Old Town.



In the early morning of July 15 every year, before the break of dawn, Kushida Shrine is filled with excitement and quiet anticipation. Then, at the signal of 4:59 a.m., with a shout, the Yamakasa carry floats come running down Kiyomichi Street with great vigor. This is the finale of the Hakata Gion Yamakasa. The moment when the floats move from stillness to motion is beyond compare. At Kushida Shrine, the main shrine of Hakata, the decorative Yamakasa floats can be seen throughout the year. From Kushida Shrine, the Omote-sando (main approach) leads to Ohaku-dori (street). Just outside the gate is Hakata Machiya Folk Museum, which was built in the style of a Hakata merchant's house. Here, visitors can learn about traditional local products, as well as the history of Yamakasa, through materials, videos, and exhibits.

Hakata Sennen-no-mon Gate and Joten-ji Street

Hakata Sennen-no-mon serves as a welcome gate to Hakata's temple and shrine area, where there are many historical and cultural assets. The gate was completed in March 2014. Beyond this gate is Joten-ji Street, home to Joten-ji Temple. Flour-based foods such as udon, soba, and steamed buns are said to have been introduced to Japan through this temple, when a monk brought back techniques for milling flour from Song China.



Hakataza Theater and Kawabata Shopping Street

Hakataza Theater is one of the largest theaters in Kyushu, located on Hakata Riverain. Various plays, including kabuki, musicals, and drama, are performed here. Next door is the Fukuoka Asian Art Museum, the only art museum in the world that systematically collects and exhibits modern and contemporary Asian art. The exhibitions, full of originality, express the ever-changing "now" of Asia. Across the road is Kawabata Shopping Street. Lined with more than 130 stores, this is a meeting place where old and new come together, while banners hung throughout the shopping street introducing humorous phrases in Hakata dialect create a welcoming atmosphere for visitors.




